1.1	During the open session two representatives of J H Walters (JHW) spoke about the former Tanya site and how development of the site forward. JHW said the site is a viable housing development site for housing. The view taken by WLDC planning is that the site is in open countryside and have turned down planning applications to develop the site and seem reluctant to engage in discussions. JHW suggested that if the development of the former Tanya site is supported by the PC it could be linked to the village in the Neighbourhood Plan and support development of the site.					
	A resident who lives near the site does not support the development because it is proposed housing rather than industrial and there were concerns that the adjacent field may be developed at some time. JWH said the site is not viable as an industrial/ office development. There are other available sites which are cheaper to develop. The site is only viable as a housing development.					
	Cllr MH said the site is an eyesore and should not be left derelict.					
	JWH commented that the support of the PC and its policies need to support development of the site and that should be clearly stated as it is apparent to JWH that WLDC been ambivalent in their assessment of PC support for the site.					
	In JHW opinion there are three options:					
	 Local District Councillors to petition WLDC and ask for further consideration of the site. Broaden the scope of the Tanya site in the neighbourhood plan. Link the Tanya site to the Central Lincolnshire Local Plan consultation. 	CD/CH NPG PC
